

Instructions: Double Major Application

Use this form if you are an undergraduate wishing to apply for a double major.

Eligibility requirements

- You must have a cumulative GPA of 4.0 or higher. Students with a lower GPA will be considered on a case-by-case basis and must provide a letter with their application explaining why an exception is justified.
- You must have completed at least three terms, including at least one in a department with a declared major. Transfer students must complete at least two terms at MIT, including at least one in a department with a declared major.
- You may not pursue a second major in the same area as your primary major or in either field of composite degrees.

What you need to do

1. Review the eligibility requirements and email curricula@mit.edu with questions.
2. Complete the application form, including required signatures from your current advisor and either an administrator or a faculty advisor from your intended second major. Departmental signature requirements vary. Be sure to confirm requirements with both your primary and secondary major.
3. Submit by email to curricula@mit.edu.

Deadlines

- Submit your application on or before Add Date of your second-to-last term.
- The CoC will consider late applications at its discretion.
